MEMORANDUM FOR JROTC Programs

SUBJECT: Invitation to the Lee County High School Tri-Meet, 3 MAR 12, Sanford, NC

1. Lee County High School JROTC will host and support its annual Tri-Meet on 3 March 2012, at the Lee County High School campus in Sanford, N.C. The Tri-Meet will include Drill, Rifle, and Raider matches with awards and trophies for individuals and teams. We intend to provide a high-quality, competitive meet that is a rewarding experience for all who attend.
2. General Operational Information:
 - a. Only schools competing in all three events are eligible for the overall Tri-Meet trophies. Guaranteed slots will be given to the first 18 Drill teams, 18 Raider teams and 16 Rifle teams who enter. All others are on a stand-by basis (2 Rifle Team slots, which are reserved for individual cadets, will be available for teams after 31 January if not filled).
 - b. All schools are to arrive no later than 0745--if you are not able to arrive on time please contact LTC Oriet. The Tri-Meet will begin with unit arrivals and check-in at 0730-0800, the commander's meeting on the track in the stadium at 0800, and will end with the Awards Ceremony at 1600 (immediately following the Knock-Out Drill).
 - c. The Drill competition will begin with regulation events in accordance with 4th Brigade Drill MOI. Fancy events are planned to be conducted simultaneously, depending on number of available graders; Individual Knock-Out-Drill with/without arms will be the final event, conducted on the football field in the stadium.
 - d. The Rifle match will be conducted in accordance with the National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle rules, 8th Edition 1 SEP 10 (2010-2012), and provide individual slots in the first and last relays for Rifle Team members that may also be a Drill or Raider Team member. All air rifles must be in cases/boxes when carried on campus, into the gym, and in the Ready Area. No Finals Round. All teams must fire on the day of the competition.
 - e. The Raider match will be in accordance with the 4th Brigade MOI. The Raider Match will be a 4th Brigade "Best of the Best" qualifying event. The "optional event" will be the Truck Pull.
 - f. Entry forms (Enclosure 1)— Fax/return to LCHS as soon as possible, but NLT 31 January 2012.
 - g. Full MOI will be emailed to your school upon receipt of entry form.

3. General Logistics Information:

- a. Parking for buses is available; the concession stand will be open.
- b. Weather— If severe inclement weather will prohibit conducting the meet, we will postpone and re-schedule. “Weather call” DTG—1200 (Noon) Friday, 2 March. If postponed, Lee County will call all units on Friday afternoon NLT 1700.
