SUBJECT: Letter of Instruction for East Surry High School's Raider Challenge.

1. PURPOSE: To provide guidance for the conduct of the East Surry High School Raider Challenge meet and information for the team preparation.

3. OBJECTIVES

- a. To promote esprit de corps, teamwork, and self-confidence among JROTC cadets.
- b. To provide JROTC teams a competitive test in five mentally and physically challenging events: Army Physical Fitness Test (modified), One-Rope Bridge, Litter Carry, Five Kilometer Road March/Run and Vehicle Pull.
- c. To recognize the best Raider Challenge Team.

4. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- a. Location of the meet will be in Pilot Mountain, NC on the School grounds.
- b. The East Surry Raider Challenge is open to the first twenty teams to pay and provide a registration form.
- c. The opening ceremonies will be held at the East Surry JROTC Department. Closing ceremonies will be held on the East Surry football field, the meet will take place from 0730-1500 hrs 4 NOV 17.
- c. Teams may have nine cadets, but only eight cadets are allowed to compete in each event with the exception of the PT Event. The Cadets must meet their individual high school requirements for extracurricular activities.
- d. The meet will be in accordance with the 4th Brigade Memorandum for Instruction 9 MAR 17.

5. COORDINATING INSTRUCTIONS:

Cadet liability: Senior Instructors (SI) must insure each cadet participating in the Raider Challenge understands the requirement for medical coverage. Additionally, each SI must ensure that the following forms are filled out by each participant and turned in during check-in prior to the competition (Please be organized to save time).

- 1) Statement of Insurance Coverage
- 2) Power of Attorney
- 3) Health and Physical Fitness Statement
- 4) Covenant not to sue
- 5) JROTC Cadet Personal Information Form

6. SERVICE AND SUPPORT:

- a. Pizza, chips and sodas will be available for purchase for lunch (\$2 Pizza, \$1 Chips and Drinks).
- b. A concession stand will be in operation.
- c. Transportation. All units are responsible for their own transportation to and from the event.
- d. ESHS will provide all equipment that is designated to be furnished by "Host School" in the 4th Brigade Memorandum for Instruction.
- e. Medical. Northern Surry Hospital is located 12 miles from ESHS and will be the primary site to treat routine and non-routine injuries.

7. CEREMONIES AND AWARDS

- a. **All teams** will have a **team guidon** and a **distinctive slogan** for the opening and closing ceremonies.
- b. Trophies and streamers will be awarded to the First, Second, and Third Place teams. Additionally, First, Second and Third Place streamers will be awarded for each event. Furthermore, First, Second and Third Place PT Event Individual Medals and Individual Raider Participant ribbons will be awarded to each participant.

8. Registration is limited to twenty teams. “First Paid, First Registered”
