MEMORANDUM FOR 4th Brigade JROTC Raider Teams

SUBJECT: Maurice J. McDonough High School AJROTC Raider Meet, Saturday, 24 March 2018

1. The Maurice J. McDonough High School AJROTC will host a Raider Meet on Saturday, 24 March 2018, beginning at 0800. Events will include the four core Raider meet events (MAPFT, one rope bridge, litter carry, and 5K road march) and a vehicle pull. If for some reason a vehicle cannot be procured for the vehicle pull, the fireman's carry relay will be substituted for the vehicle pull.
2. Participating schools may register two teams. Each team can consist of nine cadets with eight cadets participating in each event. The entry fee is \$60.00 per team. The registration form is located on the last page of this MOI. Please send the registration form and fee to McDonough High School JROTC, 7165 Marshall Corner Road, Pomfret, Maryland 20675. Registrations are due NLT 16 March so that we know how many teams to plan for.
3. The standards for the conduct of all events are found in the Fourth Brigade JROTC Raider Challenge Competition Standing Operating Procedure (SOP) dated 9 March 2017. The one exception is that the pushups and sit ups in the MAPFT will be one minute in duration.
4. The uniform for the competition is the ACU with pistol belt and full canteen and cover or camelback. Running or other type of athletic shoes are permitted for the MAPFT and the 5K road march. If weather warrants, cadets may wear a team sweatshirt and/or stocking cap in lieu of the ACU shirt and patrol cap.
5. Scoring will be as follows. A point value will be awarded based on the individual team's place in an event. First place will be awarded one point, second place two points, etc. If there is a tie in an event after the tie breaking criteria has been exhausted, the two teams will each be awarded 1.5 points. The overall winner of the competition will be the team with the least amount of total points for the competition. In the event of a tie score, the 5K Road March time will be used to break the tie.

6. The top three teams in each event and the top two teams overall will receive trophies. The male and female cadet with the highest individual score on each MAPFT event will receive a medallion.
7. The McDonough HS JROTC Booster Club will run a concession stand at a reasonable price for the convenience of the competing teams and spectators.
8. The event timeline is as follows:

0800: Units Arrive/Register

0830: Commanders Meeting

0900: Opening Ceremony/MAPFT

1100-1400: Rotate between one rope bridge, litter carry, and vehicle pull

1400: 5K road march briefing

1430: Start 5K road march

1600: Awards and Closing Ceremony.
