5th Annual Spring Invitational Sporter Class Air Rifle Postal Match
1 February - 31 March 2018

The Hoke County High School AJROTC Battalion cordially extends an invitation to your unit's rifle team to compete in our Spring Invitational Sporter Class Air Rifle Postal Match. This competition is open to Sporter air rifle shooters in your program. Sporter shooters must use **non-precision air rifles and equipment** as classified by the 2016-2018 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules for Sporter competition.

1. Participants will shoot as four (4) member teams or as individual shooters. **No shooter may be a member of more than one team. Team members cannot shoot as individuals in another class.**
2. The following information is furnished about the postal match.

SPONSOR: Hoke County High School Army JROTC "Fighting Bucks" Battalion, Raeford, North Carolina

EVENT: 3x10 Postal Air Rifle Match

EQUIPMENT CLASS: Sporter Class Only

ENTRY: Entry fee is **\$25 per team and \$5 per individual** who is not part of a team. Units may enter no more than three (3) teams, but may enter as many individuals as they wish. The **\$25.00 fee** enters all members of the team into the competition for that category. Entry forms and fees are due **NLT 15 March 2018**. Checks should be made payable to Hoke County High School AJROTC.

DATES

: Match shooting may occur any time between **01 February** and **31 March 2018**. All targets and Unit Firing Report must be postmarked no later than midnight **1 April 2018**. Failure to return targets by the date indicated may result in disqualification.

TEAMS: Teams will consist of four (4) Cadets, any gender, enrolled in the school's JROTC program. No one individual may compete on more than one team.

COURSES OF FIRE/RULES: Firing will take place on a standard 10-meter (33 feet) course measured from firing line to target. The course of fire (3 x 10) will consist of 10 shots each in the prone, standing, and kneeling positions fired in that order. One target will be used for each position. Unlimited practice shots (Sighting shots) are allowed but they must stay inside the practice oval. Any shot outside the practice oval will count as a shot on the target. All positions must be shot before the team leaves the firing line. Standard course time of 60 minutes must not be exceeded: 10 minutes-Preparation and Sighting, 10 minutes-Prone, 5 minutes-Changeover, 5 minutes-Sighting, 15 minutes-Standing, 5 minutes-Changeover, 5 minutes- Sighting, 15 minutes- Kneeling. The match

and all conditions will be governed by the 2014-2016 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules.

TARGETS: Only official AR5/10 air rifle targets will be used. Teams will provide their own targets.

TARGET IDENTIFICATION: Target stickers are **not** required. However, each target must be legibly labeled on the back side with the following information: **School Name, Team Designation (i.e. Team A), Shooter Name, Category (Precision/Sporter), and Position Fired (Prone/Standing/Kneeling)**. The Unit Firing Report must be completed by the Instructor/Coach and returned with the targets.

SCORING: Targets will not be marked or “plugged” in any fashion by participating team. Any alteration of targets may result in disqualification of the individual/team. Qualified judges will score all targets at Hoke County High School. Team member scores will be added for team aggregate.

TIED SCORES: In case of a tie, the first tiebreaker will be the highest score in the Standing position; the second tiebreaker will be the greater number of 10s, 9s, and 8s, etc. in all three positions; third tiebreaker will be the greater number of inner 10s in all three positions.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented in Sporter Team and Sporter Individual category.

Team trophies will be presented for the highest overall team scores, 1st through 3rd place. Individual medals will be presented to the shooter with the highest scores overall (Prone, Standing, and Kneeling scores combined) for each team.

Individual shooters registered as individuals will be awarded medals for the highest overall scores (Prone, Standing, and Kneeling scores combined), 1st through 3rd place. Each registered shooter will receive an individual ribbon.

RESULTS: Match results and awards will be mailed to all participating units as soon as possible after scoring and tabulation of the results have been accomplished. It is anticipated that the results will be mailed by early to mid May.
