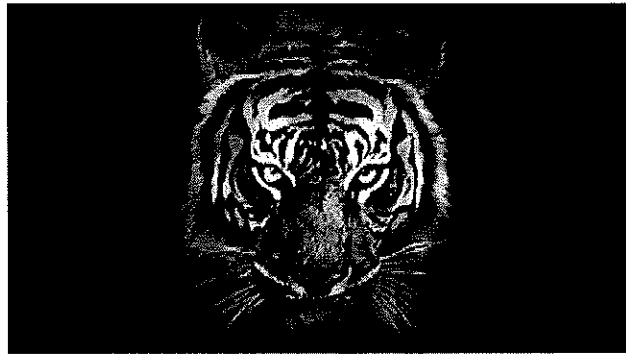

CENTRAL AIR RIFLE MEET

1. **General Information:**

Central Air Rifle Meet will be held Saturday, 24 March 2018, from 0800 hours to 1700 hours at Central High School, 17024 The Trail, King and Queen Court House, Virginia 23085. Competition starts at approximately 8:00 am and will end at approximately 5:00 pm or at the completion of firing and scoring for all participating teams. Any additional pertinent information and clarification of match procedures will be disseminated at this time.

Entry into the meet by JROTC units indicates acceptance of the MOI and constitutes their willingness for their entries to be governed, scored, and awarded recognition by provisions of the said MOI. It is the responsibility of each unit commander to ensure that each member of his/her unit is familiar with the information contained within this MOI.

All cadets, participating or viewing, are expected to exhibit the highest standards of military bearing throughout the entire competition. JROTC instructors are requested to maintain close control of their cadets, as well as of those persons who are spectators and supporters of their unit's teams.

2. **Safety and Security:**

Instructors will brief cadets on general safety prior to arrival. Security of air rifles and other personal equipment are the sole responsibility of each unit. Under no circumstance shall any weapons be left unattended for any amount of time. Team coach must accompany team to the Central High JROTC Air Rifle Meet.

3. **Team Composition:**

A school team will consist of 4 shooters of any gender that are enrolled in the school's JROTC program. The entire team will be placed on the firing line at the assigned time in numerical order to shoot along with other participating teams from other schools. The aggregate score of all team members will be used to determine the team score. There will be individual and team competitions.

*****Schools may enter more than one team. The entry fee will be assessed for each team entered.*****

4. **Course of Fire:**

Shooters will fire a 3x10 course, thirty (30) record shots; ten (10) shots from each position (prone, standing, and kneeling) fired in that order.

National Rifle Association (NRA) 3-position air rifle rules will govern the match unless otherwise outlined in this memorandum. Sporter shooters must use **non-precision air rifles and equipment** as classified by the 2016-2018 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules for Sporter competition. No slings will be used when firing from the standing position. Coaching will be allowed during the zero period only. No coaching after "Fire" command is given for record fire.

Participating teams must bring their own rifles, pellets, shooting mats, kneeling rolls, scopes, etc.

5. Scoring:

Scoring will be conducted by the host school. Firing will be conducted using the Orion targets and scoring will be done utilizing the Orion scoring system. All shots outside the sighting bulls will be scored unless brought to the attention of the range officer prior to record fire. Targets will be 10-meters from the firing line. All shooters must remain on the line until the firing line is cleared.

Targets for the meet will be provided by the host school on the day of the meet.

6. Awards:

Awards will be given to the top three teams and the top three overall individual shooters.

7. Meals/Food:

Each school is responsible for their own meals. The host school concession stand will be available for food purchases.

If food is consumed at Central HS, the cafeteria is the only designated area for food or beverages.

8. Inclement Weather:

If inclement weather is determined to be completely prohibitive, the meet will be canceled and schools will be notified as soon as possible, and meet tentatively rescheduled for the earliest possible date.
