MEMORANDUM FOR: Senior Army Instructors/Army Instructors, Army JROTC Units

Subject: Carroll County High School JROTC 1st Annual Drill Meet, 15 April 2023

1. **PURPOSE:** To provide information concerning the administration and to conduct the First Annual Carroll County JROTC Drill Meet that will be held on 15 April, 2023 at 0900 at Carroll County High School
2. **ADMINISTRATION:**
 - a. Location: 100 Cavs Lane, Hillsville, VA 24343
 - b. Fees, Registration and Events: There will be a \$ 100.00 non-refundable entry fee.
This amount will allow units to participate in all of the drill events including knockout.
Checks should be made payable to Carroll County High School JROTC and received with the entry form no later than March 1, 2023. The events available to compete in are Amered Individual-JV and Varsity, Varsity Color Guard, Unarmed Squad-JV and Varsity, Armed Squad-JV and Varsity, Unarmed Platoon-Varsity, and Platoon Inspection. A knockout event will be held at the end of the drill competition.

 - d. There will be a short Commander's meeting at 0830 on 15 April, 2023 in the Auditorium. The order of march will be disseminated at this meeting.
 - e. There are no separate male and female events. Teams may be all male or female or mixed.
3. **OPERATIONS:**
 - a. Varsity Limitations: Schools may enter only one team per event. Varsity can perform in every event available.
 - b. JV Limitations: Schools may enter only one JV Armed Individual, JV Armed Squad, JV Unarmed Squad. All JV events must be called by a LET 1A or 1B (JV meaning they are 1st year cadets).
 - c. Uniform: The uniform for this event is Class A regulation issued cadet uniforms. All authorized items should be worn (rank, ribbons, medals, etc.) Boots may not be worn. Headgear will be the issued gray berets. The ASU Service Cap is not allowed to be worn.
 - d. Weapons: Only the black issued drill rifles may be used during the competition (facsimile rifles are not authorized). Units are reminded of their responsibility to ensure weapons are secure at all times.

e. Inspection: The inspection will count in the overall results of the drill competition. It will be conducted separately from all other events. The location of this inspection will be announced at the Commander's Meeting. Platoon Leaders should be familiar with how to prepare their element for inspection (Fall-In, Open Ranks March, Dress Right, reporting into the inspecting officer etc.) Every command should be correctly given once the inspecting person tells the Platoon Leader to prepare for the inspection IAW FM 3-21.5. A total of two questions will be asked to each of the cadets during the inspection. Questions will be Chain-of-Command, Winning Colors, Drill & Ceremonies, and other basic cadet knowledge questions. Unit size for inspection should be three squads of three cadets plus one Platoon Leader/Commander (10 cadets)

f. Judging: College ROTC Cadets and National Guardsmen

g. Unit Size:

Platoon: 10 individuals minimum, including the Commander/Leader

Squad : 7 Individuals minimum, including the Commander/Leader

Color Guard: Total of 4 individuals

Individual: One cadet to perform, one cadet to call commands

h. Schedule: Drill meet will begin immediately following the Commander's Meeting

4. Awards:

Awards will be presented immediately after the last unit has completed their drill and the scores have been tabulated. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each event including knockout. Overall trophies, medals, or placards will be awarded for 1st thru 3rd place in every event. The overall winner will be determined as the unit having the most quality points in all events except knockout. Ties will be broken by the number of fives (5) a team gets on that event. In the event of a tie for one of the overall positions we will use the teams that are tied scores in the Color Guard event to break that tie and determine the overall winner.

Quality points will be awarded as follows:

1. First Place in an event - 3 points
2. Second Place in an event - 2 points
3. Third place in an event - 1 points

No Cadets will be allowed in the scoring room

GUIDELINES AND GRADING
CRITERIA
FOR PERSONNEL INSPECTION

1. Grading Criteria:

- A. Personal appearance of individual members of the drill team.
- B. Uniform: Completeness, neatness, serviceability.
- C. Shoes: Well-shined, free of dust or scuff marks, serviceable heels.
- D. Brass: Polished, correctly aligned.
- E. Hair: Proper cut for males and females.

2. Military Knowledge: Each member must answer the enclosed military-knowledge questions; properly wear uniform, grade insignia, etc.; and know the military chain of command.

Preparation for Inspection

The unit commander will report in. Once the inspector judge returns his/her salute and commands "**PREPARE FOR INSPECTION**" The platoon leader will execute an about face and give the proper commands "in accordance with FM 3-21.20.
